

PART 4


This part of our lesson talks about the Bible, why it is true, and why it is important for us to know what it says. The Bible is called "the Word of God," and is also called "the Scriptures."

Jesus Christ said that God's Word is TRUE.**




There are many words which apply to God's Word, the Bible. See if you can find these words in the word search below:

Part 5
